The auction method is the fairest way to sell, as it creates a true supply and demand environment.



In 2014 we added 32,000 square feet of building. This eliminated produce sitting in the sun while waiting to be sold. Produce is now unloaded on the floor (in rows) under the roof making it easier for buyers to walk along and see what will be sold, also allowing it to be sold faster, reducing the time buyers need to be at the auction.

For the larger buyers who don't have time to attend the auction, there will be an experienced order buyer available to buy his produce. There will be a 3% buyers fee charged for order buying. Delivery charge is extra.

• There is a 10 percent seller's charge + \$1.00 per lot charge for both growers and buyers. All purchases to be paid day of sale.


• There will be packaging restrictions to keep the product as uniform as possible. Ask for our Packaging and Grading Guide. New boxes will be available at auction.

• Consignors will be assigned permanent numbers, enabling buyers to buy more consistently.


